1. REQUIREMENTS TO NOTE

- 1.1. Completion of this form does NOT guarantee entry into Shepparton Festival 2016.
- 1.2. Shepparton Festival 2016 reserves the right to cancel involvement in the event at any time.
- 1.3. Please ensure you correctly complete this application and all relevant documentation is attached.
- 1.4. NOTIFICATION OF THE STATUS OF APPLICATIONS ARE MADE AVAILABLE VIA EMAIL FOUR WEEKS AFTER THE CLOSING DATE. NO INFORMATION WILL BE AVAILABLE BEFORE THIS DATE.
- 1.5. Due to the nature of the Festivals design we cannot guarantee your group's selection.
- 1.6 Presenters will need to attend a mandatory briefing session which will outline correct use of the media pack, logo and branding.

2. SELECTION CRITERIA

- 2.1. Shepparton Festival Board and management takes into account many factors upon making final selection.
- 2.2. The decision by the Shepparton Festival Board and management is final and no further correspondence after final selection will be entered in to.

3. INDEMNITY

- 3.1. The applicant/s agrees to indemnify and to keep indemnified the Shepparton Festival Board and management and agents, and each of them from and against all actions, costs, claims, charges, expenses, penalties, demands and damages whatsoever which may be brought or made or claimed against them, or any of them, arising from the applicant/s performance or purported performance of its obligations under this agreement and be directly related to the negligent acts, errors or omissions of the applicant/s.
The applicant/s liability to indemnify the Shepparton Festival shall be reduced proportionally to the extent that any act or omission of the Shepparton Festival Board and management or agents, contributed to the loss or liability.

4. OTHER

The event organisers take great care in planning and presenting a safe and inclusive Festival. However it is understood that in being involved in this event you agree to fully indemnify the Festival against any claim laid against it, either by members of the public or persons engaged in any activity associated with the festival who, as a result of the festival, suffer personal injury, property damage or financial loss.

- 4.1. The Applicant will advise Shepparton Festival Board and management immediately if there are any changes to your participation.
- 4.2. All participants agree that their (and those of their associated members) images and/or voices as recorded, photographed or filmed during the preparation and performance at the Shepparton Festival Board and management may be broadcast or published by the Festival in any media. This includes but is not limited to: TV, Radio, Internet, Magazine, or any other advertising in connection with Shepparton Festival and those participants will not be entitled to any fee for such use. Applicants agree to all reasonable requests for publicity for the event.
- 4.3. The participants shall conform to the requirements of the Occupational Health and Safety Act (Victoria) 2004, Local Government Act and any Local-Laws, or Regulation made there under and shall be liable for any breach of such Acts, Local Laws, or Regulations. All other Acts, Statutory Rules, Provisions and Regulation of the Commonwealth of Australia or State of Victoria, for the time being in force shall be complied with.
